

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NO. 03-02-81

**SUBJECT: PROVIDING GUIDELINES TO IMPLEMENT PRESIDENTIAL
MEMORANDUM DATED 01 FEBRUARY 1981.**

In compliance with the order and directive of the President in his Memorandum dated 01 February 1981, there are hereby issued the following implementing guidelines affecting the possession/ownership and operation of Citizen Band (CB) radio transceiver equipment:

1. The assignment of any frequency/channel within the CB radio service is hereby suspended thus no application for a permit to possess/own a CB radio transceiver equipment and for a license to operate shall be accepted/processed.
2. The assignment of any channel within the CB radio service to any civic action group is stopped, and no additional unit of CB radio transceiver equipment shall be allowed to any person, firm or association licensed to operate a CB radio station.
3. No important and sale of CB radio transceiver equipment shall be allowed.
4. The operation of a CB radio transceiver having a capability of more than 40 channels is not allowed, and the use of boosters prohibited.
5. All persons, firms, or associations authorized to operate CB radio stations with valid licenses may apply for the renewal of their licenses, except for those who are using equipment-having capability of higher than 40 channels. Existing civic action groups duly accredited by the National Telecommunications Commission (NTC) and whose members have been duly licensed to operate CB radio stations, may continue as such provided that they strictly observe the terms and conditions of the respective Memorandum of Agreements entered into by them with the NTC.
6. Any and all CB radio equipment not covered by permits to purchase/possess duly issued by the NTC that may be found to be possessed/owned by any person, firm or association and those operated or used in violation of item No. 4 hereof, shall be subject to confiscation in accordance with the provisions of the Radio Control Law, Act No. 3846, as amended, and LOI No.13-A, including those stocks of authorized radio dealers not covered by proper invoices or legitimate acquisition papers and other required documents.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately and it supersedes or amends any existing circular, order, or instruction or part thereof which is inconsistent herewith.
