

**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR**  
**NO. 10-12-86**

**SUBJECT: RADIO FREQUENCY ASSIGNMENT FOR REACT CIVIC ORGANIZATION**

Pursuant to Act 3846, as amend and other existing Radio Laws and Regulations, the following regulations, guidelines and procedure governing the installation and operations of Radio Transceivers by REACT members under close supervision of CRS-AFP are hereby promulgated:

**1. Purpose**

Authorizing REACT members to install and operate radio communication equipment for emergencies and civic action coordination under the direct supervision of CRS-AFP Region wide.

**2. Licensing Requirements and Guidelines**

For the issuance of necessary licenses for the operation of radio transceiver, the following guidelines/requirements should be strictly complied with:

- a. Bonafide members will be allowed to install/operate one (1) portable VHF transceiver and one (1) mobile station only;
- b. Provincial Chapter in every Region will be allowed to install/operate one (1) Base radio station;
- c. Base station should be operated by a Commercial Radio Operator Certificate holder;
- d. Members should undergo RLMP Seminar for subsequent issuance of RLMP Certificate;
- e. Members with approved permit to posses for radio amateur equipment will be allowed to apply for Radio Station License, provided such amateur equipment will be locked to operate on authorized radio frequency duly certified by a registered Electronics and Communications Engineer.

**3. Radio Equipment Specification**

- a. Members should install/operate type-approved commercial radio equipment crystal controlled.
- b. Members with approved permit to possess for NTC Memo Circular No. 0809-86 will be allowed to apply for radio station license provided all requirements has been complied with.

**4. Radio Frequency Assignment.**

The frequency 146.200 MHz. in lieu of 143.12 MHz. will be allocated for this purpose subject to recall upon the option of this Commission as the need arises in the interest of the service.

**5. Effectivity**

This Circular shall be effective immediately upon approval, subject to modification/revision, as the Commission deems necessary.
