

**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NO. 16-89**

**SUBJECT: PRESCRIBING REGISTRATION OF ILLEGALLY
 UNREGISTERED RADIO EQUIPMENT UNDER A SCHEDULE
 OF LIBERAL PENALTIES.**

WHEREAS, NTC Memorandum 06-16-88 dated 07 June 1988, permitted during its effectivity period registration of radio transceiver/transmitters and their accessories in order to allow holders to legitimize their possession:

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the same, there are still numerous illegally acquired and/or unregistered radio transceivers/transmitters:

NOW, THEREFORE, premises considered, it is hereby directed that for a limited period of October 23 to 23 December 1989, any person, firm, company, association or corporation shall be allowed to register their radio equipment and accessory (ies) under the following schedule of liberalized penalties, as follows:

The applicant may file their registration documents with any of the Regional Office. All equipment registered under this Circular shall be sealed.

The registration shall not be construed as an authority to operate the same without the necessary permits/licenses issued therefore, Registered equipment, however, shall remain in storage. The registration shall be without prejudice to the payment of such duties and taxes as may be imposed by the Bureau of Customs or other government agencies, The Commission further reserves the right reject registration of equipment originating from dubious source.

This Circular shall take effect immediately.
